Greetings in His Name from NJ!

In February, we coordinated a conference for small group leaders from a church in New York City. They have 30 cell groups meeting around the city and want to grow to 90 this year. These cell groups meet once a week at the place of work or in someone's home. This strategy allows inner city churches unlimited growth.

On March 13, Charles led a workshop in the Bronx for church leaders from 6 different churches on spiritual leadership principles gleaned from the book of Nehemiah. The 40 lay leaders and pastors that participated were eager to hear the Word of God and responded to the Lord by taking practical steps to help them become servant leaders.

On March 19-21, 80 people from 1st Spanish Baptist Church in Manhattan had a conference for discipling new believers and their families. The families came with hearts the Lord had prepared to listen to what He had for them through the Word.

On March 7th, we had a one-day retreat with 15 people from a new Baptist church plant in Newark, NJ. God used the 6 hours spent together to encourage, equip and strengthen this new body of believers. Along with three other leaders and pastors, we laid hands on the young man who brought an excellent message, setting him apart for the work of the ministry as an associate to the pastor.

Lastly, in our LEO headquarters another evangelical church plant has begun. Interestingly, the Lord has brought to Irvington, NJ a growing group of Quichua Indians from the southern part of Ecuador. What a joy to see the Lord's glory shining on the faces of these recent immigrants and His joy spill out as they worship and praise God with Andean type instruments.
