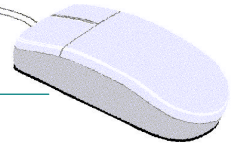

## New Horizons

The history of Christianity demonstrates that technological advances unveil new horizons through which the Gospel can spread in new and innovative ways around the world. Here are a few exciting examples...



For the apostle Paul, the Roman highway, the letter carriers, the sailing ships and the Roman judicial system were new venues for the extraordinary spread of the Gospel message all over the Roman Empire in just a few decades.

For the city of Mainz, the invention of printing was kept a church secret until the city was plundered. In a short 10 years, printing presses sprang up in Rome, Paris, Cracow and Westminster so new ideas could spread quickly.



For John Wycliffe, the idea that everyone could have a copy of the Bible to read led to the publication of the New Testament in 1380. However, what was good for the public was seen by the established church as an act of defiance.

For Gutenberg, the movable type led to the publication of the 42-line Bible of 1455 only to bring on himself a lawsuit for violating a movable type printing press.



For Martin Luther, the rapid spread of The Reformation via the printed page was vital. In Venice, for example, 40,000 copies of his work Justification by Faith were distributed within weeks of its publication in 1543.

For Jim Elliot, one of five missionaries murdered by theucas of the Amazon, the airplane made hundreds of unreachable tribes in Latin America accessible overnight with the Gospel of Christ.



For Paul E. Freed, radio flung open the door for worldwide evangelization of millions behind the iron and bamboo curtains and thousands of unreached people groups around the world.

Computers and the Internet are two effective and powerful tools LEO is using today for evangelism and discipleship.
